Age as on 1<sup>st</sup> January prior to the fleadh: Clarification re age categories: References to age determination in respect of Fleadh Rules and Bunreacht an Chomhaltais are interpreted as follows: Example: If a person's 12th birthday falls on Jan 1st then that person competes in the 12-15 age category and is similarly applied in respect of the other categories. In the event of a dispute, a certificate of age must be produced within 7 days of the competition, if requested by the County / Regional / Provincial / C.E.C. Rúnaí. Failure to do so will entail automatic disqualification.

Fleadh Entry Fees are: U-18 = €2; O-18 = €4 - for CCÉ Members, per person, per competition, in Solo, Duet & Trio;

(Non - Members = €10 & €20 per person, per competition in solo, duet or trio.) All Bands are €15 each and Grúpaí €20 each

CCÉ membership is €6 for U-18; €12 first senior O-18: €8 second senior in same family. Family: €20

Family & Senior members of CCÉ receive the Comhaltas journal 'Treoir' free of charge

At Provincial Fleadhanna and Fleadh Cheoil na hÉireann, competitors do NOT have to pay entry fees, but MUST purchase the Official Badge/wristband to gain admission to the competition venue(s).
